
Prototype testing via scale models



Transparency	Limited information about funding limitations	Sharing shelter budget and funding constraints
Shelter structure	Permanent houses	Gender-responsive evacuation centre/community centre run by Women Defenders
Participatory design approach	Co-design	Co-creation, co-design, and co-production






